WHAT'S BEEN HAPPENING:

- 2) A revised application to ABPTRFE for the **Foot and Ankle Fellowship Practice** was submitted in March. The response is pending.
- 3) FA SIG supported two physical therapists to present at the American Orthopaedic Foot and Ankle Society (AOFAS) Annual Meeting in Vancouver, Canada. Dr. Erika Nelson-Wong presented The Physical Therapists' Approach to Managing Individuals with Nerve Pain and Dr. Stephanie Albin presented Physical Therapist Interventions Dry Needling and Blood Flow Restriction.
